

1 John 3 from Popov Vasily

A it does not yet appear what we shall be (v. 1-2)

B Whoever commits sin transgresses also the law (v. 4)

C Whoever stays in him sins not (v. 6)

D let no man deceive you: he that does righteousness is righteous (v. 7)

D* He that commits sin is of the devil; for the devil sins from the beginning (v. 8)

C* Whoever is born of God does not commit sin (v. 9)

B* whoever does not righteousness is not of God (v. 10)

A* We know that we have passed from death to life (v. 14)

1 John 3:4-6

A Whoever commits sin transgresses also the law (v. 4a)

B sin is the transgression of the law (v. 4b)

B* in him is no sin (v. 5b)

A Whoever stays in him sins not (v. 6)

1 John 4

A Every spirit that **confesses** that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God
every spirit that confesses not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God (v. 1-4)

B **We are of God**: he that knows God hears us; he that is not of God hears not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error (v. 6)

C Beloved, let us love one another: for **love is of God**; and every one that loves is born of God, and knows God. (v. 7)

D **He that loves not** knows not God; for God is love (v. 8)

E **the love of God toward us**, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. (v. 9)

E* Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that **he loved us**, and **sent** his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.(v. 10)

D* if God so loved us, **we ought also to love** one another (v. 11)

C* If we love one another, God dwells in us, and **his love is perfected in us**. (v. 12)

B* Hereby know we **that we dwell in him**, and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit. (v. 13)

A* And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the world. Whoever **shall confess** that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwells in him, and he in God. (v. 14-15)

1 John 4:1-6

A whether they are of God (4:1)

B Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ ... is of God (4:2)

C ...is not of God (4:3)

C* You are of God... (4:4)

B* They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world (4:5)

A* We are of God (4:6)
